The work session was called to order at 5:32 p.m.


Executive Assistant Lisa Patterson recorded the minutes.


President Wolfe led the discussion on the options for replacing a school board vacancy. A review of the school board boundaries found that Mrs. Teweleit resided in District 4, not District 5, disqualifying her from her current election position. The boundary lines and error was confirmed by the Otero County Clerk's Office.

The Board has 45 days from the date of the resignation to fill the vacancy. If the Board does not fill the vacancy within this period, the Secretary of Education will appoint someone. The appointee will serve from the time they are appointed until December 31. President Wolfe stated that District 5 would be on the November 5 ballot and will face election to complete the unexpired term.

President Wolfe went over two possibilities of how to proceed. The first option is to set up a process and timeline of formally announcing that the Board is accepting letters of interest for those in District 5 that would like to be considered for appointment. Under this option, applicants will be evaluated and scored and the applicant with the highest score would be appointed during an open meeting. The second option would be to look at those who have already voiced an interest in being appointed to the vacancy and seeking no additional candidates. The interested applicant would then be appointed at the Regular Board Meeting on 8.21.19. Superintendent Perry stated that one letter of interest had been received and will be shared with the Board for their review before the August 21 Regular Board Meeting.

The work session adjourned at 6:05 p.m.
